UPLIFT for uterine repositioning that holds

Uterine retroversion occurs in 20% to 30% of women and can be associated with symptoms such as dyspareunia, chronic pelvic pain and dysmenorrhea.

Uterine suspension has been used successfully to lift the uterus out of the cul-de-sac after endometriosis surgery to help prevent adhesion formation,³ and as an adjunctive treatment for pelvic congestion syndrome,⁴ and to relieve pain associated with a retroverted uterus.²

UPLIFT procedure benefits

- Long-term, statistically significant reduction in dyspareunia and/or dysmenorrhea^{2,5}
- No suspension failures reported in up to two-year follow-up^{2,5}
- Case reports document that the UPLIFT procedure lasts during pregnancy - even after multiple vaginal deliveries.⁶

Uterine prolapse is a major health concern for women. Until recently, surgical treatment other than hysterectomy has been limited.

Now, there is a better alternative - the ELEVEST procedure.

The ELEVEST procedure shortens and strengthens the round and uterosacral ligaments to re-support the uterus and restore it to its correct anatomical position.
